In this information sheet, you will learn about the Self-Serve Terminal (SST) equipment features, how to open equipment doors and access cash and coin boxes

### **Self-Serve Terminal External View**

#### 1. Marketing Display

- Provides marketing and promotional information for Players
- 2. Touch Screen Display
  - Guides Players to purchase and validate Lottery products
- 3. Payment Card Terminal
  - Players will have the option to pay with Debit / Credit Cards
- 4. Ticket / Voucher Scanner
  - Validates Tickets or Vouchers
- 5. Ticket / Voucher Printer
  - Prints out Ticket purchase or Voucher
- 6. Bill Acceptor
  - Accepts all Canadian banknotes
- 7. Coin Acceptor
  - Accepts Canadian coins
- 8. Coin Return
  - Player's access point for returned coins
- 9. Keys
  - 3 colour-coded keys to open the Self-Serve Terminal

### **Keys to SST**

Each Retailer will receive 3 colour coded keys for each of the 4 locks on the SST.

<b>KEY LOCATION &amp; COLOURS</b>	
Location on SST	Key Colour
Bottom Door	Blue
Printer Door	Green
Bill Acceptor Door	Red
Coin Acceptor Door	Red

### Turning On/Off Self-Serve Terminal

1. Retailer will use the **Blue** key to open Bottom Door

- To turn the Self-Serve Terminal On or Off, use the button located on the back of the PC Unit
  - Hold down the button until the SST Touchscreen Display and Marketing Display turn off
  - Repeat steps to turn back on

#### How to Load Paper Roll

- 1. Insert paper roll as shown and pull on the leading edge of the paper towards you
- 2. Pass the paper edge above the **green plastic tensioner** and insert it on the printer head rear inlet until the printer detects it. The printer will automatically pull the paper and cut a section of it. The printer is ready for use.





#### Low Paper Warning

When the paper roll is low it will trigger a **pop-up warning** on the SST and prevent the Player from creating a Ticket.

### **Emptying the Cash Box**

1. Retailer will use the **RED** key to open Bill Acceptor Door



 Rotate Lock CLOCKWISE until in the "OPEN" position and the Lock releases





Follow steps in reverse to return the Cash Box. Cash Box is placed correctly when a \*click noise\* is heard, and unit motors begin to operate.

### **Emptying the Coin Box**

1. Retailer will use the **Blue** key to open Bottom Door

2. Use the **Red** key to unlock the Coin Box

3. Grab the Coin Box from its front handle and slide it out to collect coins
