Quick Reference Guide: Cancelling Online Tickets




In this Quick Reference Guide you will learn how to cancel Lottery Terminal printed tickets, otherwise known as Online Tickets.



Follow these steps:




- 1. Tap on the **Ticket** icon.
- 2. Tap on the Cancel tab.
- 3. Tap on Lottery.









- 1. Place the Ticket within the marked boundary of the Ticket Tray.
- 2. Let go of the Ticket so that it can be scanned by the camera.
- 3. Tap on the **Cancel Ticket** button. A Cancellation Slip will print.



- 4. The cancellation will appear as a line item in the Cart. Check the **Processed Cost** for the amount owing to the Player.
- 5. Tap **Next Player** or **Empty Cart** once you have completed the Player's request.



If the ticket is not eligible to be cancelled, you will be prompted with an error message that prevents cancellation.



Keep for 30 days

- 1. Staple the Cancellation Slip to the cancelled Ticket.
- 2. Keep for 30 days after the last draw date on the Ticket.

BCLC may require you to produce the Cancellation Slip and ticket if there is a dispute.





General Rules

Online Tickets can only be cancelled:

- 1. If the first draw on the Ticket has not yet occurred. This also applies to **Keno**, **Tickets with Advance Draws**, and **Tickets with Multiple Draws**.
- 2. At the same Retail Location where the ticket was purchased.

Tickets that <u>cannot</u> be cancelled

- 1. Free Play Tickets for Online Games cannot be cancelled.
- 2. Pacific Hold'em Poker Tickets sold in the Hospitality network cannot be cancelled.
