In this information sheet, you will learn where the Cart is located and how to edit or remove an Online Ticket in the Cart before the Player completes the purchase.

## Cart

The Cart can be found on the Lotto Games Screen


## Editing or Removing Ticket - Options

Once a Ticket is added to the Cart, there is an opportunity to make changes or remove a Ticket before Checkout. The following three tools are available:

1. Gear Icon:

- Lotto Games: Increase/Decrease Number of Tickets
- Quick Pick Packages: Add Multiple Draws and/or additional Extras

2. Trash Icon: Remove a Ticket from the Cart
3. Ticket Editor: The ability to edit the Ticket

## Gear Icon - Lotto Games



Change the Number of Tickets

1. Select the Gear icon on the line item you wish to make multiples of
2. A pop-up window will open. Select the Number of Tickets (1-10)

- Number of Tickets: Creates Ticket multiples with the lines of play identical on every Ticket
- Three exceptions: the Extra, Lotto 6/49 Gold Ball and Lotto Max lines 2 and 3 will always be unique on each Ticket

3. Tap Continue to update and navigate back to the Cart
4. Line item will update indicating Number of Tickets selected. Unprocessed cost will also update.

Change the Number of Draws and/or Extras:

1. Select the Gear icon on the line item you wish to add

## Trash Icon

1. To remove a Ticket from the Cart, select the Trash icon on the line item

2. A pop-up window will open to confirm if you want to delete the Ticket from the Cart. Tap Yes to remove and navigate back to the Cart


Remove the Quick Pick Package by deleting each line item in the Cart

## Ticket Editor

1. When a Ticket is added to the Cart, access the Ticket Editor screen by selecting anywhere on the line item

2. Once the edits have been made, select Update and navigate back to the Cart

## Ticket Editor - Features \& Functions

Ticket Editor Screens are unique to each game based how the game plays and allows for Player customization.


1. Regular/Combo, Number of Draws, Future Draws, Extra
2. Tabs for each Play
3. Numbers selected for the Play are highlighted
4. QP button will randomly select the numbers for that play

Note: Number of Tickets is not a feature on the Ticket Editor.

# Online Games How to Edit a Ticket 



## Questions \& Answers

I used the Gear Icon to change the number of Tickets in the Cart for Lotto Games, do the tickets have the same play numbers?
Yes, this is partially correct. Number of Tickets from the Gear Icon for Lotto Games will create Ticket multiples with the lines of play identical on every Ticket.
Three exceptions exist, and will always be unique on each Ticket:

- the Extra,
- the Lotto $6 / 49$ Gold Ball and,
- Lotto Max lines 2 and 3 of play

Gear Icon for Quick Pick Packages allows the Player to select Multiple Draws (1-26) with lines of play identical, and/or additional Extras (1-10).

I used the Gear Icon for Lotto Games to change the number of Tickets in the Cart. There is only one line in the cart instead of a line for each Ticket, is this right?
Yes, this is correct. When increasing the Number of Ticket by using the Gear Icon, it will show the Number of Tickets on the line item (picture below).
