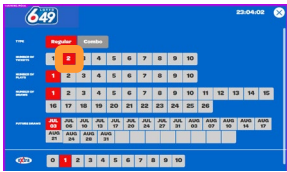
Number of Tickets Feature



When processing the sale of an Online Ticket, it's important to note that the 'Number of Tickets' feature appears in two different locations. Although the wording is the same, they perform very differently. This information sheet outlines where the two different locations are, the purpose of them, and when you might use them.

'Number of Tickets' on the:

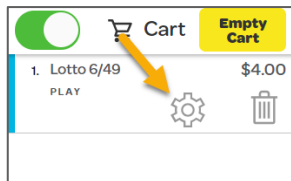
Quick Pick screen



Different main game play numbers

(This is the equivalent of printing multiple Tickets as separate transactions)

Gear icon in the Cart



Same main game play numbers

(This is the equivalent of running a Selection Slip through multiple times)



Regardless of the method used to print multiple Tickets, **every ticket is unique** because:

- System generated numbers, such as The Extra, the Gold Ball Number, Lotto Max lines 2 and 3, Wager ID and the Ticket Control Number are different on every Ticket.
- Every ticket has a unique Wager ID and Control Number. The Wager ID is a new reference number BCLC will use to identify Online Tickets - similar to the Ticket Control Number.

On the Quick Pick Screen

- Multiple Tickets with different play numbers for the main game.
- Each Ticket will display as a separate line item in the Cart with the associated cost.

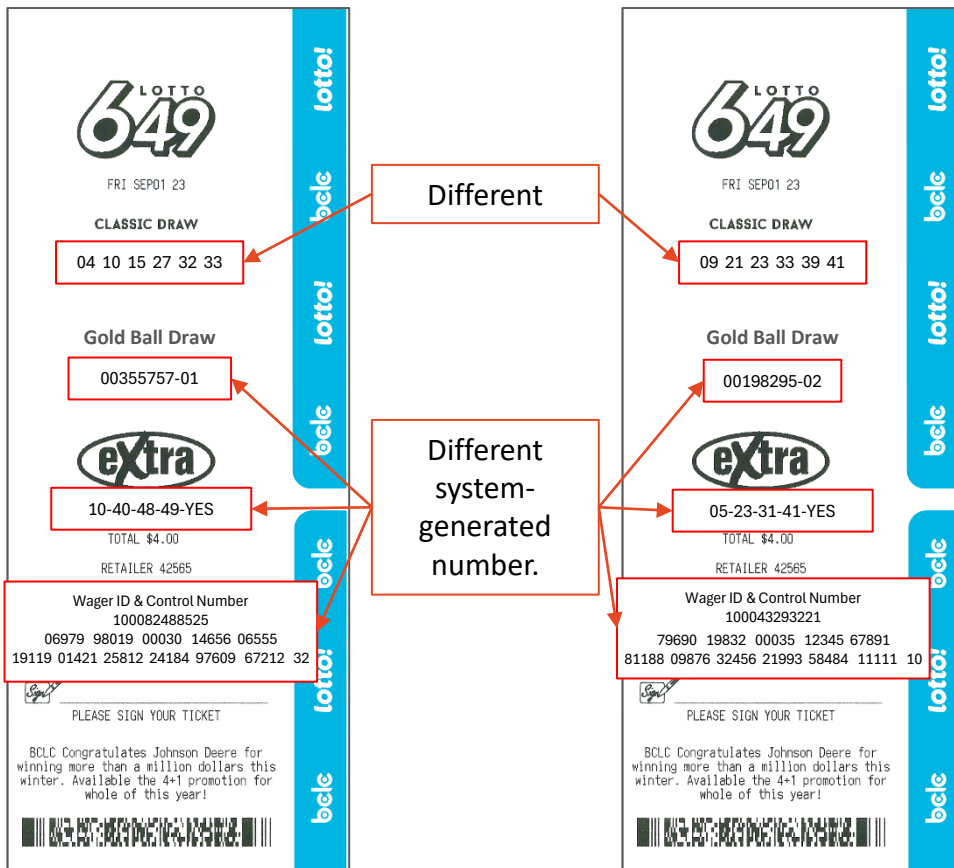

Gear Icon in the Cart

- Multiple Tickets with the same play numbers for the main game.
- The single line item in the Cart will show the number of Tickets selected, example: x3
